Its mission is to represent the plant breeding sector promoting the knowledge and recognition of its work, and at the same time defending the interests of consumers, farmers, and rural regions.




It contributes to the development of the sector through collaboration with public administrations, organisations representing different stakeholders and sectors of agricultural production and consumers.
